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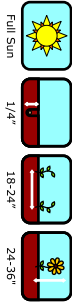
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Large umbels of Lt. Pink corollas with bright rustia hoods. Bees & butterflies adore the flowers. Most plant to the Monarch and Queen. Perennials.
Zone 3-11.



BLOOMS from Mid Summer to Early Fall.

SOW directly in garden in sandy soil in full sun in fall. Allow seeds to overwinter. Sow seeds thinly and barely cover with 1/8" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in Spring depending on soil and weather conditions.

GARDEN HINTS:

To get a head start, pre-chill seeds for 3-4 weeks, then sow seeds indoors about 6 weeks before outdoor planting time. Transplant after danger of frost. For more info, log on to Dave's Garden. <http://davesgarden.com/guides/pdf/g0/539/>

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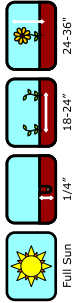


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
