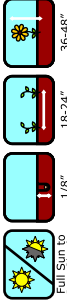

BLOOMS from Late Summer to Early Fall.

SOW directly in garden in sandy soil in full sun, from fall to early spring. Sow seeds thinly and barely cover with 1/8" of fine soil. Firm lightly and keep evenly moist. Seedlings emerge in 5-10 days depending on soil and weather conditions.

GARDEN HINTS:

To get a head start, Sow seeds indoors about 6 weeks before outdoor planting time. Transplant after danger of frost.

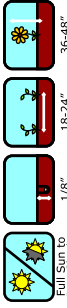

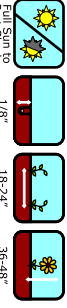

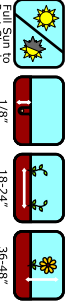
